

Style: Duns Tew (Cotswold) **Tune:** *Froggy's First Jump* by Dave Whetstone / The Albion Band **Type:** set/33" (long) stick **Dancers:** 6 (can be modified for 4) **Stepping:** Duns Tew double-step, hockle-back, foot-together-jump **Source:** Paul Handford / Thames Valley International (originally Fieldtown) **Chorus:** sticking & cross over, hockle back, FTJ; repeat. Sticking is: RB-RB-PF PB-PB-LF RB-RB-PF-PB LF-PB. Rhythm is "Peas porridge hot, peas porridge cold, peas porridge in the pot, too old!" Crossings are struts (#1 & #2) and plain capers (#3 & #4). **Sequence:** once to yourself, foot up, chorus/struts, face-to-face, chorus/struts, top-to-bottom, chorus/plain capers, bottom-to-top, chorus/plain capers, rounds & all-in
