

Style: Duns Tew (Cotswold) **Tune:** *When Johnny Comes Marching Home Again* **Type:** set/33" (long) sticks **Dancers:** 6 (can be modified for 4) **Stepping:** Duns Tew double-step, hockle-back, foot-together-jump **Source:** Jeff Bigler (2001) **Chorus:** Masters dib butts-tips, "shoot." Apprentices repeat. Half hey. Then "hand-to-hand" clashes right hand high, then left hand high, then "baseball" clashes forehand-backhand-forehand. Half hey. **Sequence:** once to yourself, foot up, chorus, face-to-face, chorus, top-to-bottom, chorus, bottom-to-top, chorus, rounds & all-in
