

Style: Duns Tew (Cotswold) **Tune:** *The Wheat Sheaf*, by Chris Ricciotti **Type:** corner/bagged hankies **Dancers:** 6 **Stepping:** Duns Tew double-steps, hockle-backs, foot-together-jump **Source:** Rob Berra / Lemon & Capers Morris **Chorus:** 4 sidesteps into center, around, and back out to new position. Repeat with 1st triangle, 2nd triangle, then everybody. At end of full chorus, dancers have traded places with their corners. **Sequence:** once to yourself, foot up, chorus, face-to-face, chorus, top-to-bottom, chorus, bottom-to-top, chorus, rounds & all-in
